**Water and sanitation facilities for clinics and communities in Niger**

Your support could help reach **3,000 mothers and their malnourished children** by: speeding up recovery time for children suffering from malnutrition; limiting the spread of diseases by installing washing and sanitation facilities; and training community members on the importance of good hygiene, keeping families healthy in the long-term.


Niger has the unfortunate accolade of being the **least developed country in the world**. A number of complex factors including malfunctioning food markets, climate change impacts, and cultural practices mean that malnutrition is a serious problem, estimated to cause nearly half of all child deaths in the country. This is a tragedy we are desperate to tackle.

In rural Agadez region, where the project is located, there is a **serious lack of safe drinking water and toilets** – even in the malnutrition treatment centres. Without these facilities, it is impossible to prevent or treat malnutrition properly. **Persistent diarrhoea** caused by waterborne diseases can lead to malnutrition, and people suffering from malnutrition are more susceptible to contracting diseases from dirty water.

The project will address this by installing water points and toilets in 10 malnutrition centres and 5 village communities over three years. We will install washing areas and facilities for safely disposing of medical waste, improving hygiene standards at the centres. We will also train community members on the importance of good hygiene, keeping kids healthy and preventing the spread of disease.

### The September 25<sup>th</sup> Walk

The two guided, not very hilly, family-friendly walks will be about 6 miles and about 4 miles long, and will start at 10am, as last year, from the entrance near the Green in Rowlands Castle, map reference 735108, near the junction of Woodberry Road and Finchdean Road. Trains to Rowlands Castle run from Portsmouth & Southsea or Petersfield.

### The October 9<sup>th</sup> Walk

The two guided walks start **promptly at 10am** from the picnic site on **Harting Hill** about a mile south of South Harting on the B2141, map ref. 791180. The longer walk is about 12 miles long and there will also be a shorter walk, about 7 miles.

### Please Note

Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult, and dogs must be kept on a lead.

What to bring...

- warm clothes, thick shoes or boots, waterproofs
- a picnic lunch
- either an entry form with your donation or this sponsor form to hand in at the registration tent before you start.
